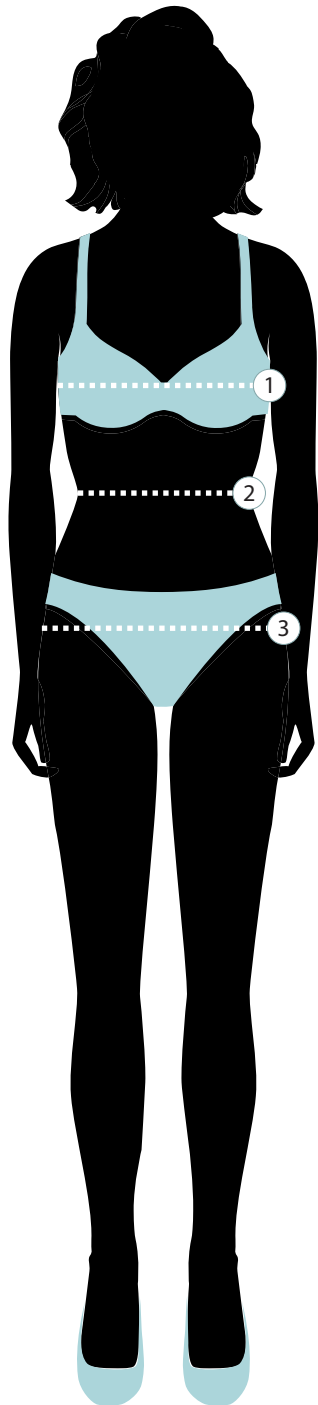


## SIZE GUIDE FOR WOMAN

### Measurements Descriptions

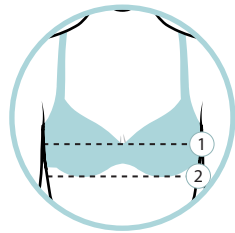
- 1) Chest width - Range where your bust is the biggest when wearing an an unpadded bra.
- 2) Waist width - Range where your waist is the smallest.
- 3) Seat width - Range where you're the widest over the seat.

### Bra size guide



To find your perfect bra fit there are two measurements that together calculate your perfect bra size. The number on your bra size decides by your underbust measurement and the difference between your chest width and underbust width calculates your cup size.

#### 1. Measure your chest width

Measure your chest where you're the widest over your bust.

#### 2. Measure your underbust width

Measure your underbust directly under your bust, as tightly as possible.

Calculate thereafter your cup size by taking your:

**Chest width - Underbust width = Cup size**

Cup size	A	B	C	D	E	F	G
<b>Difference</b>	12-14	14-16	16-18	18-20	20-22	22-24	24-26

In exempel

If you have a chest width on 93cm then you're a size 40. With an underbust width of 78cm, it gives you a difference of 15cm and looking at the table above it shows that you have a B-cup. Your bra size is then 75B.
